Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence. F18 Class Rules C.5.1(2) (compass) and C.5.2(a)(1) (Tow line) will not be subject to protest by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

Advertising

Advertising is allowed in accordance with RRS 80 and ISAF Advertising Code (Regulation 20). Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

Eligibility and Entry

The regatta is open to all F18 catamaran sailors holding CanF18 membership, which will be available for purchase at the event for CAD \$30.00. Online registration forms are at www.cat-alist.com, events section.

Schedule

Registration, Check-in and Measurement for the F18s will take place on September 23 from 1200 to 2000 at the EYC mast crane facility. Practice Races for the are planned for that afternoon. The F18s will have 3 days of racing (Sept 24-26) with the objective of 3 to 5 races per day, back to back. The first warning signal for the F18s will be at 1100 on September 24.

Registration and Check-in for the Ben Hur Regatta participants will take place on September 25 from 0830 to 0930 at the EYC clubhouse. Ben Hur Regatta will have 2 days of racing (Sept 25-26) with the objective of 3 to 5 races per day, back to back. The first warning signal for the Ben Hur will be at 1000 on September 25.

Registration & Fees

F18 - \$100 CAD / Ben Hur - \$50 CAD

Pre-registration can be made online at www.cat-alist.com or in person at EYC. Payment can be made by cash, check or credit cards, in Canadian or US funds. Entries and payment are due on or before September 24, 2009 for the F18s and September 25, 2009 for the Ben Hur Regatta.

Measurement (F18s Only)

Boats with valid measurement certificates do not need to be measured. Measurement and boat inspection will take place on September 23 from 1000-2000 at the EYC mast crane facility. Boats will be weighed in accordance with the class rules, mast down. Crew members will be weighed in accordance with the class rules. During the competition, any boat may be subject to inspection.

Venue

The Race Area will be on Lake Ontario immediately south of the entrance to Humber Bay and EYC.

RV and Trailer Parking

Boats and trailers shall be kept in the dry sail section of EYC. Motor homes may be parked south of the dry sail building.

Insurance

Each participating boat shall have current third party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of not less than **\$100,000**. Proof of this insurance must be presented at registration.
